

2008 Demographics and Epidemiology Addendum

Adopted March 4, 2009

This addendum to the 2008 Demographics and Epidemiology Report has been created as a result of a motion from SIOC (Standards, Issues and Operations Committee) regarding a discussion conducted by the Minority Advocacy Committee (MAC). The MAC committee requested some additional data be added to the Demographics and Epidemiology Report to draw attention to the disparities in our service area. The MAC committee requested that the data be further analyzed by subpopulations and include general population, rate and disparity data.

The general population data has been added for all subpopulations within the TSA (Total Service Area), EMA (Eligible Metropolitan Area) and non-EMA in Tables 1-1, 1-2 and 1-3.

Tables 1-4, 1-9 and 1-11 show the HIV and AIDS prevalence by gender, race/ethnicity, age and mode of transmission for the TSA, EMA and non-EMA, respectively. Each table shows the number of cases, the rate per 100,000 of the general population and the percentage of cases for HIV, for AIDS and for HIV/AIDS combined. Since there is no general population data available for mode of transmission, there are no calculations for rate per 100,000 in that category.

Tables 1-5, 1-10 and 1-12 show the living AIDS and HIV cases and rates per 100,000 of population by gender and race/ethnicity for the TSA, EMA and non-EMA, respectively.

Disparities in various subpopulations can easily be seen by comparing the rates per 100,000 to the total rate or the rates of other subpopulation groups. Caution should be used in relying on rate per 100,000 data when the general population size is less than 100,000. Graphs 1-1 and 1-2 give a visual representation of the disparities within the populations groups.

Tables 1-6, 1-7 and 1-8 are provided to further highlight disparities among several population groups, but this data may not be available for future reports depending on the data received from the Department of Health Bureau of HIV/AIDS.

Data for this addendum was based on the original data set from the Bureau of HIV/AIDS used to complete the original Demographics and Epidemiology Report. The case numbers for each area will not match the data tables published in the FY 2009- 2012 Ryan White Comprehensive HIV/AIDS Services Plan. Data included in the Comprehensive Plan was from a revised set of data given to us by the Bureau of HIV/AIDS.

I. Demographic Profiles

The following demographic profiles of the counties served by the West Central Florida Ryan White Care Council are included in this report to provide context for the HIV/AIDS epidemiological data to follow.

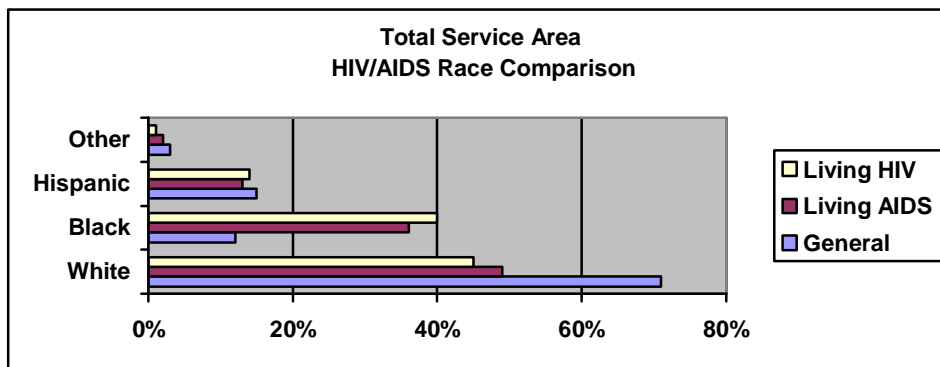

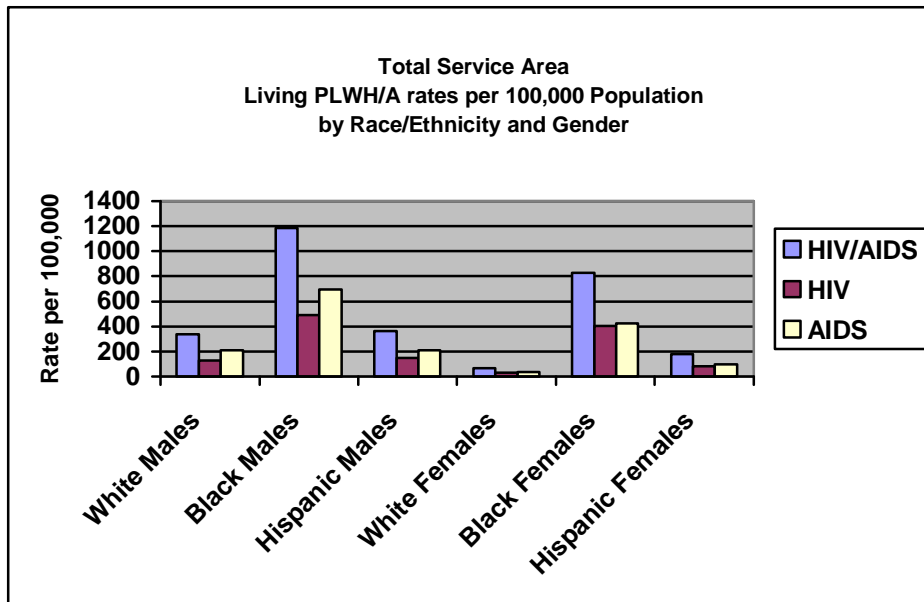

Disparities in AIDS and HIV cases can also be seen by displaying a comparison of demographic data and case data, as is shown in Graphs 1-1 and 1-2 below:

In the TSA, minorities are disproportionately affected by HIV/AIDS. As illustrated in the table, in Hillsborough County, 1 in every 89 Black individuals is infected with HIV and 1 in every 315 Hispanics compared to 1 in every 345 Whites. In Manatee County, 1 in every 80 Black individuals is infected with HIV and 1 in every 381 Hispanics compared to 1 in every 754 Whites. The data is less reliable for the counties with smaller population groups, but still useful for a general comparison.
